Information for Suppliers

Null Aerospace Rev 1 Null Aerospace (NA) provides this document on its website (nullaerospace.com) as information for suppliers. Much of this document also creates requirements for suppliers, but these requirements are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Any requirements defined here can be removed, or additional ones can be imposed, at the discretion of NA for each supplier interaction.

- NA will provide the necessary information to suppliers for quoting. This can include part numbers, drawings or models, technical requirements, or anything else to aid with the quote. These requirements will be present on the relevant NA purchase orders, but a purchase order document will not always be required. Emails containing this same information can take the place of the purchase orders. POs and quotes will be identified as approved or awaiting approval.
- NA does not currently have any competency requirements for suppliers' personnel.
- NA does not require specific kinds of communication, but email is preferred.
- NA will periodically evaluate supplier performance by requesting that suppliers complete evaluation forms provided by NA.
- NA does not currently have any design needs for suppliers.
- NA does not currently have any supplier needs that would fall under special requirements, critical items, or key characteristics.
- NA may occasionally need suppliers to test products. This could include using coordinate measuring machines to verify part dimensions. NA may indicate that all parts for a contract be tested, or just a significant sample.
- NA requires that suppliers implement QMS systems such as AS9100 or ISO 9001.
- NA requires that suppliers use external providers that meet NA's customer's approval.
- NA requires that suppliers notify NA of nonconforming products and seek NA's approval before disposing of these products.
- Suppliers will need to show NA proof of authentic parts, using certificates or other identifying information when applicable.
- If a supplier changes its products, including its sources, in any way, the supplier must notify NA and seek approval.
- When applicable, suppliers should pass along NA's requirements, including NA's customers' requirements, to their suppliers. Material certificates are an example of this.
- Suppliers should provide NA items for testing and verification when appropriate.
- Suppliers may be required to keep documentation and records of product or other information as deemed necessary by NA.
- NA and its customers may require access to certain areas of a supplier's organization, including the supplier's suppliers, in order to ensure that the supplier's products can comply with NA's requirements. NA does not currently have any activities that it needs to perform on-site at a supplier's facilities.
